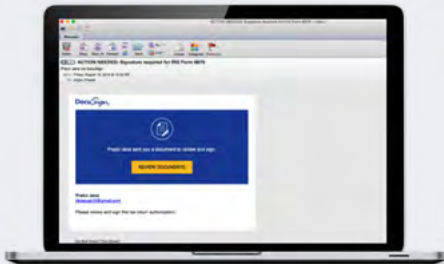

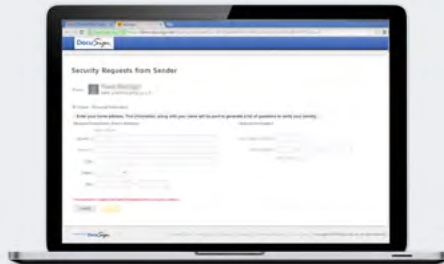

What to Expect



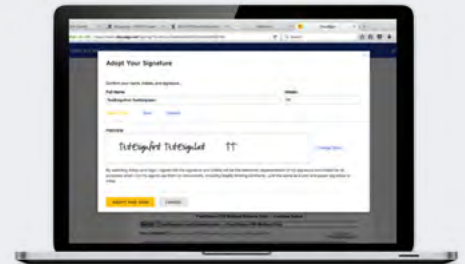
Email from tax preparer
